SUMMARY OF GCSE RESULTS AND EQUIVALENT QUALIFICATIONS

***2018 Results** : Please note that the accountability measures for schools remain in a transitional state. The new measures of Progress 8 and Attainment 8 are in their third year being used as the main performance measures for schools. However, changes to the methodology for calculating Attainment 8 means that the national average between 2016 and 2018 are not directly comparable. In the table below non-comparable results are indicated with an asterix.

Destination of Year 11 leavers (at end of Academic Year 2015 – 2016)

Number of students in Year 11 at end of their academic year 2015/16 = 155 students
