Re: Recommencement of school aged vaccination programme in clinic settings.

We are writing to inform you that the Immunisation Team, following direction from Public Health England, undertaking the completion of the school aged immunisations programme that was paused due to the COVID 19 pandemic.

We will be using the existing e-consent forms that have already been submitted by parents/carers for their children.

The vaccinations will be delivered in a COVID-19 safe clinic setting that adheres to all social distancing and infection prevention and control measures to ensure the safety of all those eligible for immunisation and the clinical staff.

Questions and Answers

How will you keep my child safe during the vaccination clinic process?

- Remain in the car until clinic appointment.
- Family contacted by phone to ask health assessment questions prior to leaving the car and entering the building.
- Your child's temperature will be checked before entering the clinic.
- A strict 1 child in, 1 child out process will be followed.
- Staff will be wearing personal protective equipment (PPE) following national guidance.
- Staff will be social distancing following national guidance.

What should I do if I am unwell on the day and not able to bring my child to the appointment?

GDPR

On the 25 May 2018 the new EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into force bringing with it improvements to Data Protection Regulations. **GDPR was enacted into UK Law by the UK Data Protection Act 2018.** Under the GDPR organisations have a statutory responsibility to have a Legal Basis when gathering and processing certain data. While we will continue to seek your explicit consent for the treatment of your child/children, your information will be processed under the following GDPR articles:

Article 6 (1) (e)

For the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority.

Article 9(2)(h)

Necessary for the reasons of preventative or occupational medicine, for assessing the working capacity of the employee, medical diagnosis, the provision of health or social care or treatment or management of health or social care systems and services on the basis of Union or Member State law or a contract with a health professional.
