

GCSE Results 2019

I would like to congratulate all our students on their GCSE achievements this year. There are many personal successes across many subject areas and I know that staff are extremely proud of them all.

With numerous national changes over the past few years, comparisons of attainment are not appropriate and headline progress measures will be unavailable until the official performance tables are released. However, students and staff at The Warwick School are proud of the improving results that our young people have achieved. 66% of students achieved a pass (grade 4-9) in English and 64% of students achieved similarly in Mathematics, a significant increase on the 2018 results. 59% of students achieved a grade 4 or above in English AND Mathematics, also a rise on last year.

Although all our students deserve recognition for their individual achievements, the following do deserve a special mention:



Jess Gavin achieved 3 x GCSEs, Grade 8 and 6 GCSEs, Grade 9.

Conal Lowe achieved 8 GCSEs, Grade 7 and above

Megan Nelstrop achieved 9 GCSEs with a grade 7 or above with Jesper Bovingdon, , Ian Roberts and Uzma Uddin all achieving 8 GCSEs with a grade 7 and above .

Laura Edwards, Max Erwood, Kaia Gray, Josh Webb and Nicolas Candau all achieved 6 GCSEs with a grade 7 or above, many achieving at least one grade 9.

Our results this year are testament to the resilience and determination of our students, staff and the support of our parent body. We look forward to a strong year next year to build on this success and we wish all our students the best for their bright futures.
