Number of students in Year 11 at end of academic year 2008/2009 = 207

Whilst the school is aware of the declared future intention of the students when they leave school after completing their public examinations (in June), both we and the Connexions Service are still awaiting some data from the Further Education Colleges and local training organisations and employers before being able to produce the final report for the Year 11 leavers in 2009. However we anticipate that the destinations of the students from this last academic year will broadly follow those of previous years.

For information, the equivalent,finalised data for the Year 11 leavers in 2008 is shown below

- 81.0 % progressed onto Further Education
- 9.1% entered employment or training
- 9.9% other or not known
